At SGAC our mission is to: Know Jesus, to Know One Another, and To Make Jesus Known. In order "to know Jesus" and "to know one another," our goal is to have every adult, who calls SGAC their home church, involved in a Growth Group.

Four great reasons to join a Growth Group:

- 1. Weekly Bible Studies will help you grow in your faith. (Psalm 119:11; 2 Timothy 3:16-17)
- 2. Prayer from others helps you get through tough times. (Philippians 4:6; 1 John 5:14-15)
- 3. You'll meet new friends. (Proverbs 27:17)
- 4. You'll have fun with other people going through the same things you are. (Ecclesiastes 4:9-10)

What is a Growth Group

Growth Groups are SGAC groups of 4 to 20+ people that meet to learn more about the Bible, grow in their faith, and meet some great new friends.

Is there a Growth Group that's right for me?

There are a variety of groups that meet at different times, days of the week, and places so that you have a chance to find the group that is right for you. You'll also have the opportunity to meet others who share your experiences and are going through similar things as you are right now.

When will my Growth Group meet?

Most groups meet once a week. Groups meet 4 times over the semester. It's a short-term commitment but the positive impact on your life will be long-term.

Where will my Growth Group meet?

Groups will be hosted in Spruce Grove and Parkland County homes, outdoor locations, and at the church.

What will the people in my Growth Group be like?

Look around on a Sunday morning. A Growth Group is made up of the same people that attend SGAC Sunday services. You will most likely see a few people that you have seen on Sunday as well as some people that you're meeting for the first time. It's a great way to get to know other people outside of Sunday service.
