- Prayer from others helps you get through tough times. (Philippians 4:6; 1 John 5:14-15)
- You'll meet new friends. (Proverbs 27:17)
- You'll have fun with other people going through the same things you are. (Ecclesiastes 4:9-10)

What is a Growth Group?

Growth Groups are SGAC groups of 4 to 20+ people that meet to learn more about the Bible, grow in their faith, and meet some great new friends.

Is there a group that's right for me?

There are a variety of groups that meet at different times, days of the weeks, and places so you'll have the chance to find the group that is right for you. And you'll have the opportunity to meet others who share your experiences and are going through similar things as you right now.

When can I sign up?

Sign-up will begin May 14, 2023.

When will my group meet?

Most Growth Groups meet once a week. Groups meet 4 times over the semester. It's a short-term commitment but the positive impact on your life will be long-term.

What will the people in my group be like?

Look around on a Sunday morning. A Growth Group is made up of the same people that attend an SGAC Sunday service. You'll most likely see a few people that you have seen on Sunday as well as some people that you're meeting for the first time. It's a great way to get to know other people outside of Sunday service.
