frequently asked questions ??

Will all the groups listed in the catalogue run for sure? Most groups require a minimum of 6 participants. You will be notified if your group has been cancelled due to a lack of registrations.

Who will be in my group?

Look around on a Sunday morning. Our groups are made up of the same people who attend an SGAC Sunday service. You'll most likely see a few people that you have seen on Sunday as well as some people that you're meeting for the first time. It's a great way to get to know people outside of Sunday service.

When do groups start/finish?

Most groups start the week of February 9 and run for 10 weeks, finishing by Easter.

When can I sign up?

Registration opens Sunday, January 26, 2025.

Where will my group meet?

Most groups meet at the church, & some meet in homes. If your group meets in a home, you will receive the address from your facilitator after you register. Days & times will vary, please see the catalogue for specifics.

Do any of the groups have childcare?

Yes, our Tuesday morning groups have childcare from 9 am to 11 am with pre-registration & limited availability.

types of groups

Activity Groups:

Provide a space to connect with others who have a similar interest. Activity Groups are a great place to invite friends who aren't connected at SGAC. Some groups require registration & some groups are drop-in.

Growth Groups:

Semester-based Bible/book/video studies designed to disciple our people. Groups are encouraged to take time to get to know each other, to pray together, & to serve at least once together. Registration is required.

Learning Groups:

These groups provide our people with an opportunity to learn about specific topics of interest. These groups follow their own schedule. Registration is required.

Life Groups:

Pilot project for groups that last multiple semesters. Established to build long-lasting & supportive relationships with others. Registration is required.

Ongoing Drop-in Groups:

Groups that don't necessarily follow the semester calendar, they usually meet throughout the majority of the ministry year. Please contact the office or the group facilitator with any questions about meeting dates.

Outreach Groups:

Designed to introduce people to the Christian Faith. Registration is appreciated.

Support Groups: Create a safe place to connect with others who share similar journeys or challenges. Registration is required.



talk about life in general & how the word of God will help an individual be transformed. We have a meal together every meeting. Starts January 26 (meets every other week).




